



## GENERAL INFORMATION

### TOURNAMENT INFO

The tournament will be conducted over the weekend of Saturday August 16 and Sunday August 17. Rain dates to be September 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>.

Registration closes on August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Participation is limited to 80 players.

The entry fee will be \$50.00 (Non-refundable).

The tournament format will consist four (4) round robin random draw rounds to determine seeding. Players will be assigned to their partner for the championship rounds based on their finish place in the round robin section.

Games will be play to 11 points, win by 2 **OR** the team with the lead at a 15-minute time limit, which ever happens first.

The championship rounds will be double elimination with the finals being best two (2) out of three (3) games, played to 11, win by 2 to determine the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams.

Top three teams will receive gold, silver or bronze medals.

All entrants will receive a commemorative Tee shirt and lunch (Burgers, hot dogs, chips and soft drinks) on Saturday. You will also receive a ticket for door prizes drawings on Saturday. Pine Tree will also provide cold water and sports drinks throughout the tournament.

Bring a folding chair, we will be providing shade cover.

The policy at Pine Tree is mandatory nudity while playing on our courts (we are a nudist club, not clothing optional). Proper footwear is required and we allow sports bras for woman and a tee shirt for those that need protection from the sun. We also recommend players bring a hat, towel, sunglasses and sunscreen as needed.
